# RME works on huge excavation in Sydney's North

RME has been contracted to handle the excavation for a large school to be erected in one of Sydney's northern suburbs. The School is part of a government funded project and is expected to be finished in August this year. The contract is in excess of \$100,000.00 through Farindon Constructions. The boys have had to excavate over 750

14 tonne excavators with rock saws and grinders. They were also required to remove over \$50,000.00 of contaminated soil from the site. On completion, the machinery had to be removed from the site by cranes. The job has taken 4 months to complete with a fantastic result.
